Brackendale Elementary School's annual School Hike will take place on **Thursday, May 25th at 1:15 in the afternoon**. Students will be called to the field behind the school, where we will assemble before beginning our hike. Primary classes will hike on our Terry Fox Route (down Government Road, through the Fall Fair trail to Ross Road, then along the Ray Peters Trail that leads past the high school and back down to BRE), and intermediate students will hike on a longer upper loop of the Ray Peters Trail.

All hikers need to wear appropriate footwear and clothing that is suitable for the weather, as we plan to hike rain or shine. Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle.
